GOD IS GRACIOUS IN GIVING REVIVAL.

“Will you be angry with us forever? Will you prolong your anger through all generations? Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you? Show us your unfailing love, O Lord, and grant us your salvation” (Ps. 85:5-7).


- Rhetorical Questions Assume an Answer When They State the Question.
 - > Will you be angry forever?
 - > Will you be unforgiving?
 - > Will you prolong your anger to all generations?
- It is an attribute of God to grant renewal, restoration, and revival to people even when not deserving.

HOPE FOR REVIVAL BECAUSE OF GOD’S PROMISE.

“I will listen to what God the Lord will say; he promises peace to his people, his saints—but let them not return to folly. Surely his salvation is near those who fear him that his glory may dwell in our land” (Ps. 85:8-9).

- Promise to love the unlovely.
- Promise of commitment to his people.
- Promise of Jesus as a new covenant with God just as Israel was under an Old Testament covenant.

“In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, ‘This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me’” (I Cor. 11:25).
