



Monthly Business Meeting - Summary of Minutes

The Monthly Business Meeting was held on **October 7, 2015**. (1) Bro. Steve Skaggs reports that the Women's Bible Study began tonight with approximately 26 women in attendance. Various women are leading the discussion weekly over the next 9 weeks and they are studying the women of the Bible. Bro. Steve also reports that a Revival Service is planned for February 28th through March 2nd of next year with Bro. Barry Fields as the evangelist. Bro. Steve also reports that the January Bible Study will reference II Corinthians and it will be completed every Sunday and Wednesday night in January except for the first Wednesday which will be Business Meeting night. Bro. Steve also reports that they have tentatively scheduled the next Couples Retreat for the last Friday and Saturday of February. (2) Mark Speer, representing the Parsonage Committee, reports that Case Foundation has completed their work on the basement walls this week and now they are ready to continue with the rest of the remodeling, including painting. (3) In New Business, David England, representing the Deacons, made motion to have the following members serve as Messengers for Muldraugh Hill Baptist Church to the Associational Meeting: Arlene Mullins, Josephine Holderman, Betty Jo Inman, Betty Helm, and Bro. Steve Skaggs. This was voted on and approved by those in attendance. (4) In New Business, Bro. Steve presented to the church that Robin Humphress, Centre Square Director in Lebanon, would like to show Christian movies to the youth of Marion County. The first one is called, "23 Blast" (information is available at outreach.com) which she would like to show to the football team next month. She is not able to do this on her own. It has to be affiliated with another organization such as a church. Bro. Steve would like for Muldraugh Hill Baptist Church to underwrite the movie at a cost of \$199, which would provide legal rights to view the movie over a period of time to these football players and may include viewing at Muldraugh Hill Baptist Church too.
